Enhanced Health in Care Homes means a number of things are happening:

- More 'ward rounds' which include more people like the physio or Occupational therapist or social worker
- Regular reviews of ALL the care needs of the residents including reviews of medication and whether all the medications are needed
- Checking out important issues like hydration, mental health and wellbeing, nutrition, falls prevention, wound care etc
- Helping maximise the independence of each resident and avoid unnecessary hospital admission
- Making sure we plan for end-of-life care and coordinate all the people who are helping to give care
- Supporting and educating the workforce and making best use of technology
