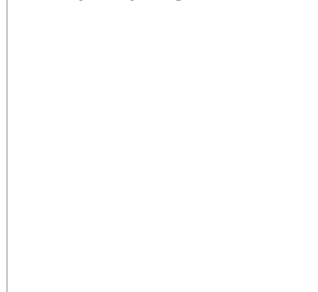
Our work focuses on three key 'themes':
