akt supports lgbtq+ young people aged 16-25 in the uk who are facing or experiencing homelessness or living in a hostile environment.

We support young people into **safe homes** and **employment, education** or **training**, in a welcoming and open environment that **celebrates lgbtq+ identities**.

akt helps young people:

- Stay safe in a crisis
- Find emergency accommodation
- Access specialist support
- Develop skills, identify and achieve life goals

we do this by providing:

- Access to advice from one of our housing specialists

- Connection to a mentor for one-to-one support
- Access to our emergency support pack or tenancy starter pack
- Accommodation with a specially trained **akt host**
- A place to stay in our **Purple Door** accommodation service
- A safe place with one of our many housing provider partners
- Access to life skills training, events and peer support networks
