Do you know the symptoms of bowel cancer?

The most common are:

- Bleeding from your bottom and/or blood in your poo
- A persistent and unexplained change in bowel habit
- Unexplained weight loss
- Extreme tiredness for no obvious reason
- A pain or lump in your stomach

These symptoms don't always mean bowel cancer, but if you have one or more of the symptoms listed, make an appointment with your GP as soon as possible.

*The age range for bowel cancer screening is being lowered, you may receive a test before the age of 54. If you are 75 or over, you can request a test kit by calling 0800 707 6060.
