

Breast screening saves around 1,300 lives each year in the UK.

If you are aged between 50 and 70 years old and registered with a North Tyneside GP, you will receive a routine breast screening invitation every three years. When it is your turn to be invited you will receive a letter in the post.

Breast cancer is the most common cancer in the UK. The NHS breast screening programme aims to detect breast cancer at a very early stage when treatment is most effective.

If you are concerned about changes to your breasts, do not wait for your screening appointment and seek advice from your GP as soon as possible.
